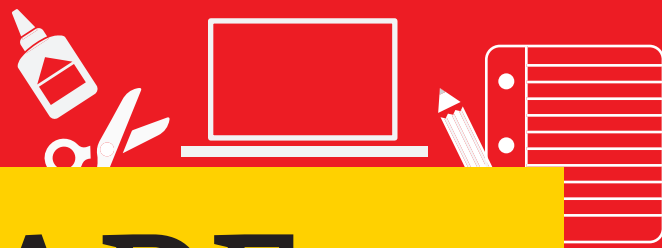

### Technology:

- Set of headphones with a microphone

### Educational Supplies (Please label with your first and last name!):

- Bible—The New International Young Reader’s Version Discovery Bible, Revised Edition
- Clip board – There are some good ones at Dollar Tree
- Crayola Brand Crayons (24 count)
- Crayola Brand water colors (make sure there is actually paint in the tray, not just a ‘one-time-use’ smear of color)
- Pack of Crayola brand Colored pencils (12 pack)
- 2 Red ink pens--(for self and peer correction of work)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- Erasers – 2 large white (erases better than the pink)
- Scissors
- Washable markers—Crayola one package
- 1 two pocket folder. Choice up to student for take home folder.
- 5 plastic double-pocket folders with three-tab center loose leaf page holders— (Blue = Reading; Red =Math; Green = Writing; Yellow = Science; Orange = Social Studies)



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- 4 wide ruled composition books—at least one with multiplication tables in the back.
